

Read the following paragraph aloud:

In addition to the following the instructions that you will receive at your start time, we are asking you to keep a list, in order, of all roads that you are on or that you cross that have a type of tree in their name. For the purposes of this task only, this includes private roads (which you should never drive on) – basically anything with any type of street sign counts for the tree list. If you drive on or cross a tree street multiple times, write it down multiple times in the correct order. Write your ordered list of tree streets to the right of the column of navigation instructions that you will receive. To avoid uncertainty about what we are counting as a tree, we have provided you a list of tree names below. **Some** of the names in this list will appear on the course. The list below includes just the tree part, not the complete street name. Your list should include the complete names of tree streets that you cross or drive on.
